SINCE OUR FIRST MEETING IN 1881, THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN (AAUW) HAS WORKED AS A NATIONWIDE COMMUNITY TO BREAK THROUGH BARRIERS FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS. TODAY, MORE THAN 100,000 MEMBERS, DONORS, AND COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY PARTNERS ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND AROUND THE WORLD COME TOGETHER TO SUPPORT AAUW'S MISSION OF ADVANCING EQUITY THROUGH ADVOCACY, EDUCATION, PHILANTHROPY, AND RESEARCH.

WHAT WE DO

AAUW's impact keeps growing as we continue our legacy of action, from our neighborhoods to the national stage:

In the classroom. AAUW provides more than \$4 million each year in graduate fellowships, grants, campus project support, and undergraduate scholarships. We also conduct groundbreaking research on diverse topics, including women and girls in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics fields; the gender pay gap; sexual harassment; cyber bullying; and many more.

On college campuses. AAUW programs develop leaders, train women to run for student government and elective office, teach salary negotiation skills, enforce Title IX compliance, and provide grants for projects that fight sexual harassment, sexual assault, gender-based discrimination, and pay inequality.

In the courtroom. The AAUW Legal Advocacy Fund gives financial and administrative support to plaintiffs in gender-based education and employment discrimination cases that have the potential to set precedent. LAF also provides an online lawyer-referral service and a legal-resource library.

On Capitol Hill. AAUW is a leading voice for public policies that support women and their families. We successfully advocate on critical issues like unfair pay, gender discrimination, Social Security, educational issues, and women's health care, just to name a few.
