AAUW has signed an amicus brief for *Christian Legal Society v. Martinez*, a case that will be [argued before the U. S. Supreme Court](#). The court will rule whether or not the University of California Hastings College of Law may deny school funding to a religious student organization because the group requires its officers and voting members to agree with its religious viewpoints. The U.S. Court of Appeals for the 9th Circuit upheld the university's policy. AAUW joins other amicus signers in supporting the school, the separation of church and state, and religious liberty.
