The parties in *Foltz et al. v. Delaware State University*, an important class action Title IX lawsuit brought by members of the university's women's equestrian team, have reached [a settlement](#). The settlement requires DSU to comply with Title IX's requirements to provide equitable participation opportunities and recruitment support to women's athletics. [LAF provided funding](#) for an expert witness.
