

## What is the AAUW Leadership Corps?

The AAUW Leadership Corps is a group of volunteer field organizers from across the country that concentrates on talent scouting, branch development, and mentoring future leaders. Committed to strengthening AAUW and trained to seek out potential leaders in our midst, the Leadership Corps is available to serve as a resource to AAUW branches, states, and national members.

## Who makes up the Leadership Corps?

The Leadership Corps comprises up to 50 field organizers with a passion for AAUW's mission, a vision for AAUW's future, and a talent for seeing and inspiring leadership in others. Field organizers are AAUW member leaders who have applied for and been accepted to a two-year volunteer position with the Leadership Corps.

## What are the goals of the Leadership Corps?

The Leadership Corps aims to

- Strengthen inclusive outreach and collaboration to build overall AAUW membership with emphasis on branch revitalization, member acquisition, and the establishment of new branches
- Support states, branches, and members in the promotion of the AAUW mission, mission-based programming, and activism to break through educational and economic barriers so that all women have a fair chance
- Keep members informed about current AAUW activities, priorities, successes, and challenges, facilitating effective, multi-way communication among all levels of our AAUW community

- developing new branches
- identifying and mentoring leaders throughout AAUW
