- Facilitate leadership development and training for member leaders and mentor potential leaders.
- Communicate AAUW mission and program priorities to the membership.
- Share members' input and concerns with the AAUW Board of Directors and staff.
- Facilitate the sharing of resources and ideas to strengthen program planning and implementation, fundraising, activism, and other activities related to AAUW's mission.
- Participate in ongoing training to hone communication and organizational skills.
