On behalf of the undersigned organizations representing patients, providers, and researchers, we thank you for introducing a Resolution expressing support for the designation of a "Women's Health Research Day." We applaud the acknowledgment in the resolution of the January 2016 National Institutes of Health (NIH) policy to require investigators to consider sex as a critical biological variable in federally funded research. We agree that more needs to be done to include women in clinical trials and to investigate sex specific effects in research.

A significant component of rigor and completeness in research is the investigation of sex specific effects.
