Welcome to the Washington, DC area! The NCCWSL Steering Committee and Staff have outlined a few recommendations should you have some time to explore. Please note, these are *recommendations* - you are responsible for doing the research, securing tickets, and transportation to and from your destination.

Please note many museums and sites require guests to pass through metal detectors/security before entry, and bag checks are often required. Be sure to visit the location's Plan Your Visit page to check security requirements before you go.

There are several services that offer temporary luggage storage so that you don't have to carry your belongings throughout the day. <u>Bounce</u> and <u>Luggage Hero</u> are two convenient to the DC area. The National Museum of American History and the Natural History Museum also have coin-operated lockers. These lockers are narrow (think high school lockers) so carry ons might be too wide. The National Gallery of Art has a checkroom that allows luggage to museum visitors.

Lyft has generously sponsored a code for this year's NCCWSL conference! You may use the code to receive a discount to and from the airport, train station, metro, touring, or any other destination while attending NCCWSL.
