Priority 2: Removing Barriers to Success in Education and the Workplace

Educational Environments

Fighting to ensure educational spaces are inclusive and free from harassment by supporting vigorous enforcement of Title IX and other civil rights laws.

Affordable Education

Working to improve access to affordable and inclusive higher education for women that yields high-quality credentials and degrees.

Workplace Equity

Championing legislation supporting paid family and medical leave, paid sick days, pay equity, and robust workplace harassment protections.

Skill Development

Supporting students, staff, and faculty with salary negotiation and financial literacy training, and other equity and inclusion efforts.



Priority 2: Removing Barriers to Success in Education and the Workplace

National AAUW

Direct federal policy advocacy on core issues affecting women's equity and opportunity.

- Title IX and civil rights enforcement
- Workplace protections including paid leave
- Anti-harassment legislation

Skill-building training for branches and campus initiatives nationwide.

Branch/State AAUW

Grassroots action on AAUW priority issues or those with local community impact.

- State/local policy initiatives and representation
- Leverage AAUW National resources
- Campus work with students and faculty

Mobilize members for coordinated national action with regional focus.

Branch and state activities strengthen our ability to empower women locally.






AAUW's strength comes from our collective actions. When we unite our efforts, we create powerful change for women in education.
